## On-Air Test Structure

Each on-air test should take about 10 minutes. You should come to the test with 2-3 songs in mind to play on air. This is what you can expect for the On-Air Test:

### **Beginning of Test:**

- Transition from automation to on Air
- Turning on mics for everyone on show (yourself and the proctor)
- Introduce the show including the show name, your name, and the **legal ID**
- Let the listeners know what song you're playing first
- Start playing your first song

### **Middle of Test:**

- Maintaining proper volume levels
- Proctor will call into the station. Make sure you screen the caller first. Then, once you transfer the call to the board, alert the caller they are on air. Drop the call when finished
- Transition between songs

### **Finishing up the show:**

- Fade out of music, & turn your mic back on
- Sign off, with the name of the show, your name, legal ID
- Transition from on air back into automation
- Transmitter log
